Neg: I don't practice playing the piano every day.

3) She enjoys going to concerts.

Neg: She doesn't enjoy going to concerts.

4) The flowers need water every day.

Neg: The flowers don't need water every day.

5) I enjoy watching sports.

Neg: I don't enjoy watching sports.

6) You take the bus to work.

Neg: You don't take the bus to work.

7) She writes in her journal.

Neg: She doesn't write in her journal.

8) We listen to music while driving.

Neg: We don't listen to music while driving.

9) They study together for exams.

Neg: They don't study together for exams.

10) The cat catches mice.

Neg: The cat doesn't catch mice.
