- 86)**    **Pos.**    Sarah has been working on her art project all day.  
          **Neg.**    Sarah has not been working on her art project all day.  
          **Que.**    Has Sarah been working on her art project all day?

- 87)**    **Pos.**    The children have been playing outside for hours.  
          **Neg.**    The children have not been playing outside for hours.  
          **Que.**    Have the children been playing outside for hours?

- 88)**    **Pos.**    He has been working on his car all day.  
          **Neg.**    He has not been working on his car all day.  
          **Que.**    Has he been working on his car all day?
- 

- 89)**    **Pos.**    She has been baking cookies since this morning.  
          **Neg.**    She has not been baking cookies since this morning.  
          **Que.**    Has she been baking cookies since this morning?

- 90)**    **Pos.**    Tom has been working on his novel all weekend.  
          **Neg.**    Tom has not been working on his novel all weekend.  
          **Que.**    Has Tom been working on his novel all weekend?
