86) Pos. Sarah has been working on her art project all day.

Neg. Sarah has not been working on her art project all day.

Que. Has Sarah been working on her art project all day?

87) Pos. The children have been playing outside for hours.

Neg. The children have not been playing outside for hours.

Que. Have the children been playing outside for hours?

88) Pos. He has been working on his car all day.

Neg. He has not been working on his car all day.

Que. Has he been working on his car all day?

89) Pos. She has been baking cookies since this morning.

Neg. She has not been baking cookies since this morning.

Que. Has she been baking cookies since this morning?

90) Pos. Tom has been working on his novel all weekend.

Neg. Tom has not been working on his novel all weekend.

Que. Has Tom been working on his novel all weekend?
