1) The students have not been studying for the test all day.

**Pos:** The students have been studying for the test all day.

Que: Have the students been studying for the test all day?

2) You have not been working on the project all day.

Pos: You have been working on the project all day.

Que: Have you been working on the project all day?

3) He has not been playing the piano for three hours.

**Pos:** He has been playing the piano for three hours.

Que: Has he been playing the piano for three hours?

4) She has not been painting since morning.

**Pos:** She has been painting since morning.

Que: Has she been painting since morning?

5) They have not been practicing their lines for weeks.

**Pos:** They have been practicing their lines for weeks.

Que: Have they been practicing their lines for weeks?
