1) The students have been studying for the test all day.

Neg: The students have not been studying for the test all day.

Que: Have the students been studying for the test all day?

2) You have been working on the project all day.

Neg: You have not been working on the project all day.

Que: Have you been working on the project all day?

3) He has been playing the piano for three hours.

Neg: He has not been playing the piano for three hours.

Que: Has he been playing the piano for three hours?

4) She has been painting since morning.

Neg: She has not been painting since morning.

Que: Has she been painting since morning?

5) They have been practicing their lines for weeks.

Neg: They have not been practicing their lines for weeks.

Que: Have they been practicing their lines for weeks?
