

Exercise -Future Perfect Continuous Tense (Key)

1) Will the workers have been constructing the building for a year?

Pos: The workers will have been constructing the building for a year.

Neg: The workers will not have been constructing the building for a year.

2) Will I have been studying English for six months?

Pos: I will have been studying English for six months.

Neg: I will not have been studying English for six months.

3) Will you have been working on the project for several hours?

Pos: You will have been working on the project for several hours.

Neg: You will not have been working on the project for several hours.

4) Will he have been practicing the piano all day?

Pos: He will have been practicing the piano all day.

Neg: He will not have been practicing the piano all day.

5) Will she have been studying for the exam since morning?

Pos: She will have been studying for the exam since morning.

Neg: She will not have been studying for the exam since morning.
