The students have not been studying for the test all

Neg. day.

Que. Have the students been studying for the test all day?

92) Pos. You have been working on the project all day.

Neg. You have not been working on the project all day.

Que. Have you been working on the project all day?

93) Pos. He has been playing the piano for three hours.

Neg. He has not been playing the piano for three hours.

Que. Has he been playing the piano for three hours?

94) Pos. She has been painting since morning.

Neg. She has not been painting since morning.

Que. Has she been painting since morning?

95) Pos. They have been practicing their lines for weeks.

Neg. They have not been practicing their lines for weeks.

Que. Have they been practicing their lines for weeks?
