91) Pos. I had been studying English for three hours.

Neg. I had not been studying English for three hours.

Que. Had I been studying English for three hours?

92) Pos. He had been playing the guitar for two hours.

Neg. He had not been playing the guitar for two hours.

Que. Had he been playing the guitar for two hours?

93) Pos. She had been writing her novel since morning.

Neg. She had not been writing her novel since morning.

Que. Had she been writing her novel since morning?

94) Pos. We had been waiting for the train for half an hour.

Neg. We had not been waiting for the train for half an hour.

Que. Had we been waiting for the train for half an hour?

95) Pos. They had been practicing their dance routine for weeks.

Neg. They had not been practicing their dance routine for

weeks.

Que. Had they been practicing their dance routine for weeks?
