- 91)**    **Pos.**    The workers will have been constructing the building for a year.  
          **Neg.**    The workers will not have been constructing the building for a year.  
          **Que.**    Will the workers have been constructing the building for a year?
- 

- 92)**    **Pos.**    I will have been studying English for six months.  
          **Neg.**    I will not have been studying English for six months.  
          **Que.**    Will I have been studying English for six months?
- 

- 93)**    **Pos.**    You will have been working on the project for several hours.  
          **Neg.**    You will not have been working on the project for several hours.  
          **Que.**    Will you have been working on the project for several hours?
- 

- 94)**    **Pos.**    He will have been practicing the piano all day.  
          **Neg.**    He will not have been practicing the piano all day.  
          **Que.**    Will he have been practicing the piano all day?
- 

- 95)**    **Pos.**    She will have been studying for the exam since morning.  
          **Neg.**    She will not have been studying for the exam since morning.  
          **Que.**    Will she have been studying for the exam since morning?
