

## <u>Exercise -Past Perfect Continuous Tense</u> (<u>Key</u>)

1) I had been studying English for two hours.

Neq: I had not been studying English for two hours.

Que: Had I been studying English for two hours?

2) You had been working on this project all day.

Neg: You had not been working on this project all day.

Que: Had you been working on this project all day?

3) He had been playing the guitar since the morning.

Neg: He had not been playing the guitar since the morning.

Que: Had he been playing the guitar since the morning?

4) She had been cooking dinner for the family.

Neg: She had not been cooking dinner for the family.

Que: Had she been cooking dinner for the family?

5) We had been waiting for the bus for half an hour.

Neg: We had not been waiting for the bus for half an hour.

Que: Had we been waiting for the bus for half an hour?
