



Present Perfect Continuous Tense **Write Interrogative Sentences (Key)**

1) I have been studying for three hours.

Que: *Have I been studying for three hours?*

2) You have been working hard all day.

Que: *Have you been working hard all day?*

3) He has been practicing the piano since morning.

Que: *Has he been practicing the piano since morning?*

4) She has been cooking dinner for us.

Que: *Has she been cooking dinner for us?*

5) We have been exercising at the gym.

Que: *Have we been exercising at the gym?*

6) They have been playing basketball since noon.

Que: *Have they been playing basketball since noon?*

7) It has been raining all day.

Que: *Has it been raining all day?*

8) John has been studying Spanish for a month.

Que: *Has John been studying Spanish for a month?*

9) Sarah has been working on her project.

Que: *Has Sarah been working on her project?*

10) The children have been playing in the park.

Que: *Have the children been playing in the park?*
