1) Pos. I have been studying for three hours.

Neg. I have not been studying for three hours.

Que. Have I been studying for three hours?

2) Pos. You have been working hard all day.

Neg. You have not been working hard all day.

Que. Have you been working hard all day?

3) Pos. He has been practicing the piano since morning.

Neg. He has not been practicing the piano since morning.

Que. Has he been practicing the piano since morning?

4) Pos. She has been cooking dinner for us.

Neg. She has not been cooking dinner for us.

Que. Has she been cooking dinner for us?

5) Pos. We have been exercising at the gym.

Neg. We have not been exercising at the gym.

Que. Have we been exercising at the gym?
