**1)** It has not been raining heavily all afternoon.

**Pos:** It has been raining heavily all afternoon.

**2)** John has not been studying for the exam since morning.

**Pos:** John has been studying for the exam since morning.

---

**Que:** Has John been studying for the exam since morning?

---

**3)** Sarah has not been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

**Pos:** Sarah has been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

---

**Que:** Has Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?

---

**4)** The workers have not been building the house for months.

**Pos:** The workers have been building the house for months.

---

**Que:** Have the workers been building the house for months?

---

**5)** I have not been reading a book for the past hour.

**Pos:** I have been reading a book for the past hour.

---

**Que:** Have I been reading a book for the past hour?

---
