2) John has not been studying for the exam since morning.

**Pos:** John has been studying for the exam since morning.

Que: Has John been studying for the exam since morning?

3) Sarah has not been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

**Pos:** Sarah has been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

Que: Has Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?

4) The workers have not been building the house for months.

**Pos:** The workers have been building the house for months.

Que: Have the workers been building the house for months?

5) I have not been reading a book for the past hour.

**Pos:** I have been reading a book for the past hour.

Que: Have I been reading a book for the past hour?
