1) It has been raining heavily all afternoon.

Neg: It has not been raining heavily all afternoon.

Que: Has it been raining heavily all afternoon?

2) John has been studying for the exam since morning.

Neg: John has not been studying for the exam since morning.

Que: Has John been studying for the exam since morning?

3) Sarah has been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

Neg: Sarah has not been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

Que: Has Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?

4) The workers have been building the house for months.

Neg: The workers have not been building the house for months.

Que: Have the workers been building the house for months?

5) I have been reading a book for the past hour.

Neg: I have not been reading a book for the past hour.

Que: Have I been reading a book for the past hour?
