

## Exercise -Past Perfect Continuous Tense (Key)

**1)** It had been raining heavily all afternoon.

**Neg:** It had not been raining heavily all afternoon.

---

**Que:** Had it been raining heavily all afternoon?

---

**2)** John had been studying for the exam since morning.

**Neg:** John had not been studying for the exam since morning.

---

**Que:** Had John been studying for the exam since morning?

---

**3)** The workers had been building the house for months before it was completed.

**Neg:** The workers had not been building the house for months before it was completed.

---

**Que:** Had the workers been building the house for months before it was completed?

---

**4)** He had been playing the piano for three hours.

**Neg:** He had not been playing the piano for three hours.

---

**Que:** Had he been playing the piano for three hours?

---

**5)** She had been painting since morning.

**Neg:** She had not been painting since morning.

---

**Que:** Had she been painting since morning?
