

<u>Exercise -Past Perfect Continuous Tense</u> (<u>Key</u>)

1) It had not been raining heavily all afternoon.

Pos: It had been raining heavily all afternoon.

Que: Had it been raining heavily all afternoon?

Z) John had not been studying for the exam since morning.

Pos: John had been studying for the exam since morning.

Que: Had John been studying for the exam since morning?

The workers had not been building the house for months before it was completed.

Pos: The workers had been building the house for months before it was completed.

Que: Had the workers been building the house for months before it was completed?

4) He had not been playing the piano for three hours.

Pos: He had been playing the piano for three hours.

Que: Had he been playing the piano for three hours?

5) She had not been painting since morning.

Pos: She had been painting since morning.

Que: Had she been painting since morning?
