Neg: We will not have been waiting in line for two hours.

2) Will they have been playing soccer for the entire afternoon?

Pos: They will have been playing soccer for the entire afternoon.

Neg: They will not have been playing soccer for the entire afternoon.

3) Will John have been working as a chef for ten years?

Pos: John will have been working as a chef for ten years.

Neg: John will not have been working as a chef for ten years.

4) Will Sarah have been traveling around the world for months?

Pos: Sarah will have been traveling around the world for months.

Neg: Sarah will not have been traveling around the world for months.

5) Will I have been working on this project for six months?

Pos: I will have been working on this project for six months.

Neg: I will not have been working on this project for six months.
