



Past Continuous Tense

Write Interrogative Sentences (Key)

1) The children weren't playing in the park.

Pos: *Were the children playing in the park?*

2) Mary wasn't reading a book.

Pos: *Was Mary reading a book?*

3) John wasn't cooking dinner.

Pos: *Was John cooking dinner?*

4) The birds weren't singing in the trees.

Pos: *Were the birds singing in the trees?*

5) We weren't studying together at the library.

Pos: *Were we studying together at the library?*

6) You weren't playing soccer in the field.

Pos: *Were you playing soccer in the field?*

7) They weren't having a picnic by the lake.

Pos: *Were they having a picnic by the lake?*

8) It wasn't snowing heavily.

Pos: *Was it snowing heavily?*

9) She wasn't dancing in the ballet performance.

Pos: *Was she dancing in the ballet performance?*

10) The teacher wasn't explaining the lesson.

Pos: *Was the teacher explaining the lesson?*
