5) We were studying together at the library.

Neq: We weren't studying together at the library.

6) You were playing soccer in the field.

Neg: You weren't playing soccer in the field.

7) They were having a picnic by the lake.

Neg: They weren't having a picnic by the lake.

8) It was snowing heavily.

Neg: It wasn't snowing heavily.

9) She was dancing in the ballet performance.

Neg: She wasn't dancing in the ballet performance.

10) The teacher was explaining the lesson.

Neg: The teacher wasn't explaining the lesson.
