96) Pos. It has been raining heavily all afternoon.

Neg. It has not been raining heavily all afternoon.

Que. Has it been raining heavily all afternoon?

97) Pos. John has been studying for the exam since morning.

Neg. John has not been studying for the exam since morning.

Que. Has John been studying for the exam since morning?

98) Pos. Sarah has been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

Neg. Sarah has not been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

Que. Has Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?

99) Pos. The workers have been building the house for months.

Neg. The workers have not been building the house for months.

Que. Have the workers been building the house for months?

100) Pos. I have been reading a book for the past hour.

Neg. I have not been reading a book for the past hour.

Que. Have I been reading a book for the past hour?
