2) You were playing video games all night.

Neg: You were not playing video games all night.

Que: Were you playing video games all night?

3) They were attending a concert.

Neg: They were not attending a concert.

Que: Were they attending a concert?

4) It was snowing lightly.

Neg: It was not snowing lightly.

Que: Was it snowing lightly?

5) The children were laughing uncontrollably.

Neg: The children were not laughing uncontrollably.

Que: Were the children laughing uncontrollably?
