**1)** They have been playing basketball since noon.

**Neg:** They have not been playing basketball since noon.

---

**Que:** Have they been playing basketball since noon?

---

**2)** It has been raining all day.

**Neg:** It has not been raining all day.

---

**Que:** Has it been raining all day?

---

**3)** John has been studying Spanish for a month.

**Neg:** John has not been studying Spanish for a month.

---

**Que:** Has John been studying Spanish for a month?

---

**4)** Sarah has been working on her project.

**Neg:** Sarah has not been working on her project.

---

**Que:** Has Sarah been working on her project?

---

**5)** The children have been playing in the park.

**Neg:** The children have not been playing in the park.

---

**Que:** Have the children been playing in the park?

---
