1) They have been playing basketball since noon.

**Neg:** They have not been playing basketball since noon.

Que: Have they been playing basketball since noon?

2) It has been raining all day.

Neg: It has not been raining all day.

Que: Has it been raining all day?

3) John has been studying Spanish for a month.

Neg: John has not been studying Spanish for a month.

Que: Has John been studying Spanish for a month?

4) Sarah has been working on her project.

**Neg:** Sarah has not been working on her project.

Que: Has Sarah been working on her project?

5) The children have been playing in the park.

**Neg:** The children have not been playing in the park.

Que: Have the children been playing in the park?
