

<u>Exercise -Past Perfect Continuous Tense</u> (<u>Key</u>)

1) They had not been studying for the exam all week.

Pos: They had been studying for the exam all week.

Que: Had they been studying for the exam all week?

2) It had not been raining since yesterday afternoon.

Pos: It had been raining since yesterday afternoon.

Que: Had it been raining since yesterday afternoon?

3) John had not been working out at the gym every day.

Pos: John had been working out at the gym every day.

Que: Had John been working out at the gym every day?

4) Sarah had not been practicing her presentation all morning.

Pos: Sarah had been practicing her presentation all morning.

Que: Had Sarah been practicing her presentation all morning?

5) The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon.

Pos: The children had been playing in the park all afternoon.

Que: Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon?
