**1)** They had not been studying for the exam all week.

**Pos:** They had been studying for the exam all week.

**Que:** Had they been studying for the exam all week?

**2)** It had not been raining since yesterday afternoon.

**Pos:** It had been raining since yesterday afternoon.

---

**Que:** Had it been raining since yesterday afternoon?

---

**3)** John had not been working out at the gym every day.

**Pos:** John had been working out at the gym every day.

---

**Que:** Had John been working out at the gym every day?

---

**4)** Sarah had not been practicing her presentation all morning.

**Pos:** Sarah had been practicing her presentation all morning.

---

**Que:** Had Sarah been practicing her presentation all morning?

---

**5)** The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon.

**Pos:** The children had been playing in the park all afternoon.

---

**Que:** Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon?

---
