**Pos:** *Has it been snowing heavily since morning?*

**8)** Mary has not been playing the piano for years.

**Pos:** *Has Mary been playing the piano for years?*

**9)** Tom has not been working on his car all weekend.

**Pos:** *Has Tom been working on his car all weekend?*
