4) She had been working on her computer all day.

Que: Had she been working on her computer all day?

5) We had been traveling around Europe for weeks.

Que: Had we been traveling around Europe for weeks?

6) They had been talking on the phone for hours.

Que: Had they been talking on the phone for hours?

7) It had been snowing since early morning.

Que: Had it been snowing since early morning?

8) Mary had been playing tennis for years.

Que: Had Mary been playing tennis for years?

9) Tom had been working on his car all weekend.

Que: Had Tom been working on his car all weekend?

10) The students had been studying English grammar lately.

Que: Had the students been studying English grammar lately?
