Neg: It was not raining lightly.

Que: Was it raining lightly?

4) The children were playing with their toys.

Neg: The children were not playing with their toys.

Que: Were the children playing with their toys?

5) She was wearing a yellow dress.

Neg: She was not wearing a yellow dress.

Que: Was she wearing a yellow dress?
