

## Exercise -Past Continuous Tense (Key)

1) You were studying for the exam.

Neq: You weren't studying for the exam.

Que: Were you studying for the exam?

2) He was watching TV.

**Neg:** He wasn't watching TV.

Que: Was he watching TV?

3) It was raining outside.

Neg: It wasn't raining outside.

Que: Was it raining outside?

4) We were traveling to Paris.

**Neg:** We weren't traveling to Paris.

Que: Were we traveling to Paris?

5) They were talking on the phone.

**Neg:** They weren't talking on the phone.

Que: Were they talking on the phone?
