1) I have not been reading a book since morning.

**Pos:** I have been reading a book since morning.

Que: Have I been reading a book since morning?

2) You have not been watching TV all evening.

Pos: You have been watching TV all evening.

Que: Have you been watching TV all evening?

3) He has not been practicing his speech.

**Pos:** He has been practicing his speech.

Que: Has he been practicing his speech?

4) She has not been baking a cake for the party.

**Pos:** She has been baking a cake for the party.

Que: Has she been baking a cake for the party?

5) We have not been working on this project for weeks.

**Pos:** We have been working on this project for weeks.

Que: Have we been working on this project for weeks?
