1) I have been reading a book since morning.

Neg: I have not been reading a book since morning.

Que: Have I been reading a book since morning?

2) You have been watching TV all evening.

Neg: You have not been watching TV all evening.

Que: Have you been watching TV all evening?

3) He has been practicing his speech.

Neg: He has not been practicing his speech.

Que: Has he been practicing his speech?

4) She has been baking a cake for the party.

Neg: She has not been baking a cake for the party.

Que: Has she been baking a cake for the party?

5) We have been working on this project for weeks.

Neg: We have not been working on this project for weeks.

Que: Have we been working on this project for weeks?
