Pos: You had been working on the project all day long.

Neg: You had not been working on the project all day long.

3) Had he been playing video games since morning?

Pos: He had been playing video games since morning.

Neg: He had not been playing video games since morning.

4) Had she been cooking dinner for the party all evening?

Pos: She had been cooking dinner for the party all evening.

Neg: She had not been cooking dinner for the party all evening.

5) Had we been traveling for hours before we reached our destination?

Pos: We had been traveling for hours before we reached our destination.

Neg: We had not been traveling for hours before we reached our destination.
