**1)** We have not been waiting for the bus for an hour.

**4)** He has not been playing the guitar since this morning.

**Pos:** *Has he been playing the guitar since this morning?*

**5)** She has not been cooking dinner for the family.

**Pos:** *Has she been cooking dinner for the family?*

**6)** We have not been waiting for the bus for half an hour.

**Pos:** *Have we been waiting for the bus for half an hour?*

---

**7)** They have not been studying for the exam all week.

**Pos:** *Have they been studying for the exam all week?*

---

**8)** It has not been raining since yesterday afternoon.

**Pos:** *Has it been raining since yesterday afternoon?*

---

**9)** John has not been working out at the gym every day.

**Pos:** *Has John been working out at the gym every day?*

**10)** Sarah has not been practicing her presentation all morning.

**Pos:** *Has Sarah been practicing her presentation all morning?*
