7) It had been raining since morning when we decided to go outside.

Neg: It had not been raining since morning when we decided to go outside.

8) John had been working out at the gym regularly before he got injured.

Neg: John had not been working out at the gym regularly before he got injured.

Sarah had been practicing her presentation for days before the conference.

Neg: Sarah had not been practicing her presentation for days before the conference.

The children had been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

Neg: The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.
