11) Pos. I have been reading a book since morning.

Neg. I have not been reading a book since morning.

Que. Have I been reading a book since morning?

12) Pos. You have been watching TV all evening.

Neg. You have not been watching TV all evening.

Que. Have you been watching TV all evening?

13) Pos. He has been practicing his speech.

Neg. He has not been practicing his speech.

Que. Has he been practicing his speech?

14) Pos. She has been baking a cake for the party.

Neg. She has not been baking a cake for the party.

Que. Has she been baking a cake for the party?

15) Pos. We have been working on this project for weeks.

Neg. We have not been working on this project for weeks.

Que. Have we been working on this project for weeks?
