11) Pos. I had been studying English for two hours.

Neg. I had not been studying English for two hours.

Que. Had I been studying English for two hours?

12) Pos. You had been working on the project all day long.

Neg. You had not been working on the project all day long.

Que. Had you been working on the project all day long?

13) Pos. He had been playing video games since morning.

Neg. He had not been playing video games since morning.

Que. Had he been playing video games since morning?

14) Pos. She had been cooking dinner for the party all evening.

Neg. She had not been cooking dinner for the party all

evening.

Que. Had she been cooking dinner for the party all evening?

15) Pos. We had been traveling for hours before we reached our destination.

Neg. We had not been traveling for hours before we reached our destination.

Que. Had we been traveling for hours before we reached our destination?
