2) They help out at the local charity.

Neg: They don't help out at the local charity.

Que: Do they help out at the local charity?

3) The flowers bloom in vibrant colors.

Neg: The flowers don't bloom in vibrant colors.

Que: Do the flowers bloom in vibrant colors?

4) The dog wags its tail when it's excited.

Neg: The dog doesn't wag its tail when it's excited.

Que: Does the dog wag its tail when it's excited?

5) I enjoy reading books.

Neg: I don't enjoy reading books.

Que: Do I enjoy reading books?
