1) They have not been discussing the issue for hours.

Pos: They have been discussing the issue for hours.

Que: Have they been discussing the issue for hours?

2) It has not been snowing heavily since morning.

Pos: It has been snowing heavily since morning.

Que: Has it been snowing heavily since morning?

3) Mary has not been playing the piano for years.

Pos: Mary has been playing the piano for years.

Que: Has Mary been playing the piano for years?

4) Tom has not been working on his car all weekend.

Pos: Tom has been working on his car all weekend.

Que: Has Tom been working on his car all weekend?

5) The students have not been studying for exams.

Pos: The students have been studying for exams.

Que: Have the students been studying for exams?
