Pos: Had they attended the meeting?

2) Had I finished my homework before dinner?

Pos: I had finished my homework before dinner.

3) Had you visited London last year?

Pos: You had visited London last year.

4) Had he already left when I arrived?

Pos: He had already left when I arrived.

5) Had she cooked dinner before the guests arrived?

Pos: She had cooked dinner before the guests arrived.

6) Had they traveled to Europe before the pandemic?

Pos: They had traveled to Europe before the pandemic.

7) Had it stopped raining before we went outside?

Pos: It had stopped raining before we went outside.

8) Had John read the book before watching the movie?

Pos: John had read the book before watching the movie.

9) Had Sarah finished her presentation before the meeting?

Pos: Sarah had finished her presentation before the meeting.

Pos: The train had departed by the time we reached the station.
