Pos: Had I finished my homework before dinner?

3) You had not visited London last year.

Pos: Had you visited London last year?

4) He had not already left when I arrived.

Pos: Had he already left when I arrived?

5) She had not cooked dinner before the guests arrived.

Pos: Had she cooked dinner before the guests arrived?

6) They had not traveled to Europe before the pandemic.

Pos: Had they traveled to Europe before the pandemic?

7) It had not stopped raining before we went outside.

Pos: Had it stopped raining before we went outside?

8) John had not read the book before watching the movie.

Pos: Had John read the book before watching the movie?

9) Sarah had not finished her presentation before the meeting.

Pos: Had Sarah finished her presentation before the meeting?

10) The train had not departed by the time we reached the station.

Pos: Had the train departed by the time we reached the station?
