Neg: They had not attended the meeting.

2) I had finished my homework before dinner.

Neg: I had not finished my homework before dinner.

3) You had visited London last year.

Neg: You had not visited London last year.

4) He had already left when I arrived.

Neg: He had not already left when I arrived.

5) She had cooked dinner before the guests arrived.

Neg: She had not cooked dinner before the guests arrived.

6) They had traveled to Europe before the pandemic.

Neg: They had not traveled to Europe before the pandemic.

7) It had stopped raining before we went outside.

Neg: It had not stopped raining before we went outside.

8) John had read the book before watching the movie.

Neg: John had not read the book before watching the movie.

9) Sarah had finished her presentation before the meeting.

Neg: Sarah had not finished her presentation before the meeting.

10) The train had departed by the time we reached the station.

Neg: The train had not departed by the time we reached the station.
