1) Had they been working on the project for weeks?

**Pos:** They had been working on the project for weeks.

Neq: They had not been working on the project for weeks.

2) Had it been raining heavily all day?

Pos: It had been raining heavily all day.

Neg: It had not been raining heavily all day.

Had John been studying for the exam for months before he finally passed?

Pos: John had been studying for the exam for months before he finally passed.

Neg: John had not been studying for the exam for months before he finally passed.

4) Had Sarah been writing her novel for years before she finally published it?

Pos: Sarah had been writing her novel for years before she finally published it.

Neg: Sarah had not been writing her novel for years before she finally published it.

Had the construction workers been building the house for several months before it was completed?

Pos: The construction workers had been building the house for several months before it was completed.

Neg: The construction workers had not been building the house for several months before it was completed.
