



Present Perfect Continuous Tense **Write Interrogative Sentences (Key)**

1) The children have not been playing in the park all afternoon.

Pos: *Have the children been playing in the park all afternoon?*

2) I have not been reading this book for the past few days.

Pos: *Have I been reading this book for the past few days?*

3) You have not been watching TV for hours.

Pos: *Have you been watching TV for hours?*

4) He has not been studying Spanish for months.

Pos: *Has he been studying Spanish for months?*

5) She has not been working on her computer all day.

Pos: *Has she been working on her computer all day?*

6) We have not been traveling around Europe for weeks.

Pos: *Have we been traveling around Europe for weeks?*

7) They have not been talking on the phone for hours.

Pos: *Have they been talking on the phone for hours?*

8) It has not been snowing since early morning.

Pos: *Has it been snowing since early morning?*

9) Mary has not been playing tennis for years.

Pos: *Has Mary been playing tennis for years?*

10) The students have not been studying English grammar lately.

Pos: *Have the students been studying English grammar lately?*
