



Present Perfect Continuous Tense **Write Interrogative Sentences (Key)**

1) The children have been playing in the park all afternoon.

Que: *Have the children been playing in the park all afternoon?*

2) I have been reading this book for the past few days.

Que: *Have I been reading this book for the past few days?*

3) You have been watching TV for hours.

Que: *Have you been watching TV for hours?*

4) He has been studying Spanish for months.

Que: *Has he been studying Spanish for months?*

5) She has been working on her computer all day.

Que: *Has she been working on her computer all day?*

6) We have been traveling around Europe for weeks.

Que: *Have we been traveling around Europe for weeks?*

7) They have been talking on the phone for hours.

Que: *Have they been talking on the phone for hours?*

8) It has been snowing since early morning.

Que: *Has it been snowing since early morning?*

9) Mary has been playing tennis for years.

Que: *Has Mary been playing tennis for years?*

10) The students have been studying English grammar lately.

Que: *Have the students been studying English grammar lately?*
