**Neg.** It has not been snowing heavily since morning.  
**Que.** Has it been snowing heavily since morning?

- 18)** **Pos.** Mary has been playing the piano for years.  
**Neg.** Mary has not been playing the piano for years.  
**Que.** Has Mary been playing the piano for years?

- 19)** **Pos.** Tom has been working on his car all weekend.  
**Neg.** Tom has not been working on his car all weekend.  
**Que.** Has Tom been working on his car all weekend?

- 20)** **Pos.** The students have been studying for exams.  
**Neg.** The students have not been studying for exams.  
**Que.** Have the students been studying for exams?
