1) We have not been waiting for the bus for an hour.

Pos: We have been waiting for the bus for an hour.

Que: Have we been waiting for the bus for an hour?

2) I have not been studying English for two hours.

Pos: I have been studying English for two hours.

Que: Have I been studying English for two hours?

3) You have not been working on this project all day.

Pos: You have been working on this project all day.

Que: Have you been working on this project all day?

4) He has not been playing the guitar since this morning.

Pos: He has been playing the guitar since this morning.

Que: Has he been playing the guitar since this morning?

5) She has not been cooking dinner for the family.

Pos: She has been cooking dinner for the family.

Que: Has she been cooking dinner for the family?
