

<u>Exercise -Present Perfect Continuous Tense</u> (<u>Key</u>)

1) We have been waiting for the bus for an hour.

Neg: We have not been waiting for the bus for an hour.

Que: Have we been waiting for the bus for an hour?

2) I have been studying English for two hours.

Neg: I have not been studying English for two hours.

Que: Have I been studying English for two hours?

3) You have been working on this project all day.

Neg: You have not been working on this project all day.

Que: Have you been working on this project all day?

4) He has been playing the guitar since this morning.

Neg: He has not been playing the guitar since this morning.

Que: Has he been playing the guitar since this morning?

5) She has been cooking dinner for the family.

Neg: She has not been cooking dinner for the family.

Que: Has she been cooking dinner for the family?
