1) I had been working on this project for several hours.

Neg: I had not been working on this project for several hours.

Que: Had I been working on this project for several hours?

2) You had been studying English for a long time before the exam.

Neg: You had not been studying English for a long time before the exam.

Que: Had you been studying English for a long time before the exam?

3) He had been playing the piano since he was a child.

Neg: He had not been playing the piano since he was a child.

Que: Had he been playing the piano since he was a child?

4) She had been waiting at the airport for three hours.

Neg: She had not been waiting at the airport for three hours.

Que: Had she been waiting at the airport for three hours?

5) We had been traveling for two days before we arrived at our destination.

Neg: We had not been traveling for two days before we arrived at our destination.

Que: Had we been traveling for two days before we arrived at our destination?
