**Pos:** I had been working on this project for hours.

**Neg:** I had not been working on this project for hours.

**2)** Had you been studying for the exam all night?

**Pos:** You had been studying for the exam all night.

---

**Neg:** You had not been studying for the exam all night.

---

**3)** Had she been cooking dinner for the family all evening?

**Pos:** She had been cooking dinner for the family all evening.

---

**Neg:** She had not been cooking dinner for the family all evening.

---

**4)** Had it been snowing heavily all day?

**Pos:** It had been snowing heavily all day.

---

**Neg:** It had not been snowing heavily all day.

---

**5)** Had John been studying French for months before his trip to Paris?

**Pos:** John had been studying French for months before his trip to Paris.

---

**Neg:** John had not been studying French for months before his trip to Paris.

---
